

MODHSS renews WIC Contract with PCHD

The Pulaski County Health Department has announced that a contract to continue to provide WIC services for fiscal year 2011 has been signed with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. Under the terms of the contract, the Pulaski County Health Department will be able to serve 1860 persons eligible for WIC every month.
