## MOBILE FOOD VENDOR PRE-OPEN CHECKLIST

**Facility must call the inspector a minimum of 15 days in advance to schedule a pre-open inspection.**

The following items will be checked during the pre-open inspection.

1. All applicable fees have been paid. Fees can be paid online.
2. Food grade hose with container and water source is approved.
3. Temperature logs, cleaning log, illness policy, and commissary agreement.
4. Gray water tank is 15% larger than the potable water tank.
5. Bacteriological test on potable water tank is absent (negative). Mobile unit will receive 1 free water test per year, additional tests are \$30 each.
6. Water temperature is a minimum of 100 F and has adequate pressure.
7. Restroom is available for employees. Location:
8. Food cannot be prepared or stored in a private residence.
9. Refrigeration units are on and have a thermometer in the warmest part of the unit to measure air temperature.
10. Sanitizer and test strips are available.
11. Food thermometers and gloves are available.
12. Surfaces of equipment are smooth, easily cleanable, non-absorbent and in good repair.
13. Facility has barriers in place to prevent the entry of pests.
14. Facility has access to an outdoor trash receptacle. Location:
15. Facility will have 60 days to ensure all food employees have completed a food manager or food handler course.
16. For hood ventilation questions, please contact local fire district.
17. For waste disposal questions, please contact local utilities or sewer district.
18. First routine inspection will occur in approximately 30 days. Food manager and handler documentation must be readily available.

Please note that this mobile unit is only approved to operate in the jurisdiction it has been approved for. Any operation outside of the approved jurisdiction, whether for regular business or a temporary event, may require a separate permit.

The Pulaski County Health Center follows the 2013 Missouri Food Code along with county food ordinance.
